



**ENFORCEMENT NOTES:**

1. All harvested big game must be brought to the hunter check station. All harvest data identified in the Base Bulletin must be provided before leaving the hunter check station.
2. Hunters must be checked out from hunting no later than one and one half hours after sunset.
3. Baiting wildlife is prohibited in all areas on MCB, Camp Lejeune, MCAS, New River and OLF, Oak Grove.
4. Hunter **MUST** wear a cap AND a vest (or garment) of solid international (hunter) ORANGE color material visible on both front and back of the upper torso except when hunting waterfowl, wild turkey, dove or bow hunting, within a bow hunting area.
5. No gun hunting, including organized hunting, in impact areas or within 200 yards of built-up areas. No Bow hunting is allowed within 100 yards of built-up areas.
6. Seasons and bag limits are authorized in accordance with state law.
7. Rifles are not authorized. Pistols are only authorized as identified in Base Order 5090.115.
8. Only properly licensed hunters/wood cutters are authorized to enter designated training areas for hunting or wood cutting.
9. Due to the volume of training and daily maintenance during the work week, hunting will only be allowed on weekends.
