(Immediate Requirements- MEF Readiness)

-<u>Provide</u> a secure environment for tenants and families in order to enable life-support, ForceGen operations and training within, power projection from and recovery to our installations.

LOE 1- Enable and Support II MEF and Tenants

- Garrison support vectored toward tenant unit mission success
- Mobility and maneuver enhanced ISO MEF Deployments & Exercises
