1. It is requested that 2d Reconnaissance Battalion receive authorization to transport ammunition and explosives (A&E) off base from the Camp Lejeune Ammunition Supply Point (ASP) Bldg SH50 Hope Road, Camp Lejeune, NC 28547 to Tier 1 Training Group (TIG) Ammunition Storage Compound, Bldgs RSM 1 AND RSM 2, 3100 Angeletti Rd, Crawfordsville, AR 72327.

2. Unit's point of contact for individual receiving the A&E at the ASP is: Lance Corporal Amiredward Ballestero, 2d Reconnaissance Battalion Ammunition Technician, (313) 938-6926, amiredward.ballestero@usmc.mil. Unit's point of contact for the individual receiving the A&E at the destination is: Capt Mitchell Moore, 2d Reconnaissance Battalion Bravo Company Platoon Commander, (317) 385-4340, mitchell.moore@usmc.mil.

3. Ammunition will be prepared for shipment 16 May 2022 at the Camp Lejeune ASP with certified representatives from 2d Reconnaissance Battalion who will assist the Ammunition Technicians for blocking and bracing procedures in order to properly prepare the explosive laden vehicle for shipment. Scheduled date of departure from the Camp Lejeune ASP to TIG Bldgs RSM1 and RSM2 is 17 May 2022 at 0800, arriving at the training site 18 May 2022 NLT 0800. Over the course of one day, ammo will be transported from the Camp Lejeune ASP to the TIG compound in one box truck. In the event that not all ammunition was expired and a turn-in is required, certified blocking and bracing representatives and Ammo Technicians from 2d Reconnaissance Battalion will block and brace the remaining ammunition in the explosive laden vehicle and transport it back to the Camp Lejeune ASP at the conclusion of the exercise 11 June 2022.

4. The shipment will originate from the Camp Lejeune Ammunition Supply Point (ASP) Bldg SH50 Hope Road, Camp Lejeune, NC 28547; the destination is the TIG Ammunition Storage Compound, Bldgs RSM 1 AND RSM 2, 3100 Angeletti Rd, Crawfordsville, AR 72327.

5. Security plan: The explosive laden vehicle will have two certified Ammunition Drivers, one of which will serve as an armed guard equipped with their Table of Organization weapon which they have qualified on within the last 12 months. Both Ammunition Drivers will alternate serving as the armed guard as necessary. The armed guard will have two full magazines of security ammunition on their person. Company leadership will follow in a chaser vehicle to ensure no mishaps or accidents occur.

6. Communication Plan: All Drivers and A-Drivers will be equipped with cellular phones, phone chargers, and wireless phone battery chargers. Prior to departing Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, the A-Driver will contact the Ammunition Chief, Sergeant Kleaton D. Williams at (225) 290-3688 and the S-4 Logistics Officer in Charge,

9. Recovery Plan: In the case of a vehicle breakdown, the Platoon leadership and A-Drivers will contact the rental agency for assistance. The Battalion Officer of the Day, Logistics Officer, and Ammunition Chief will be contacted and kept up to date about the situation.

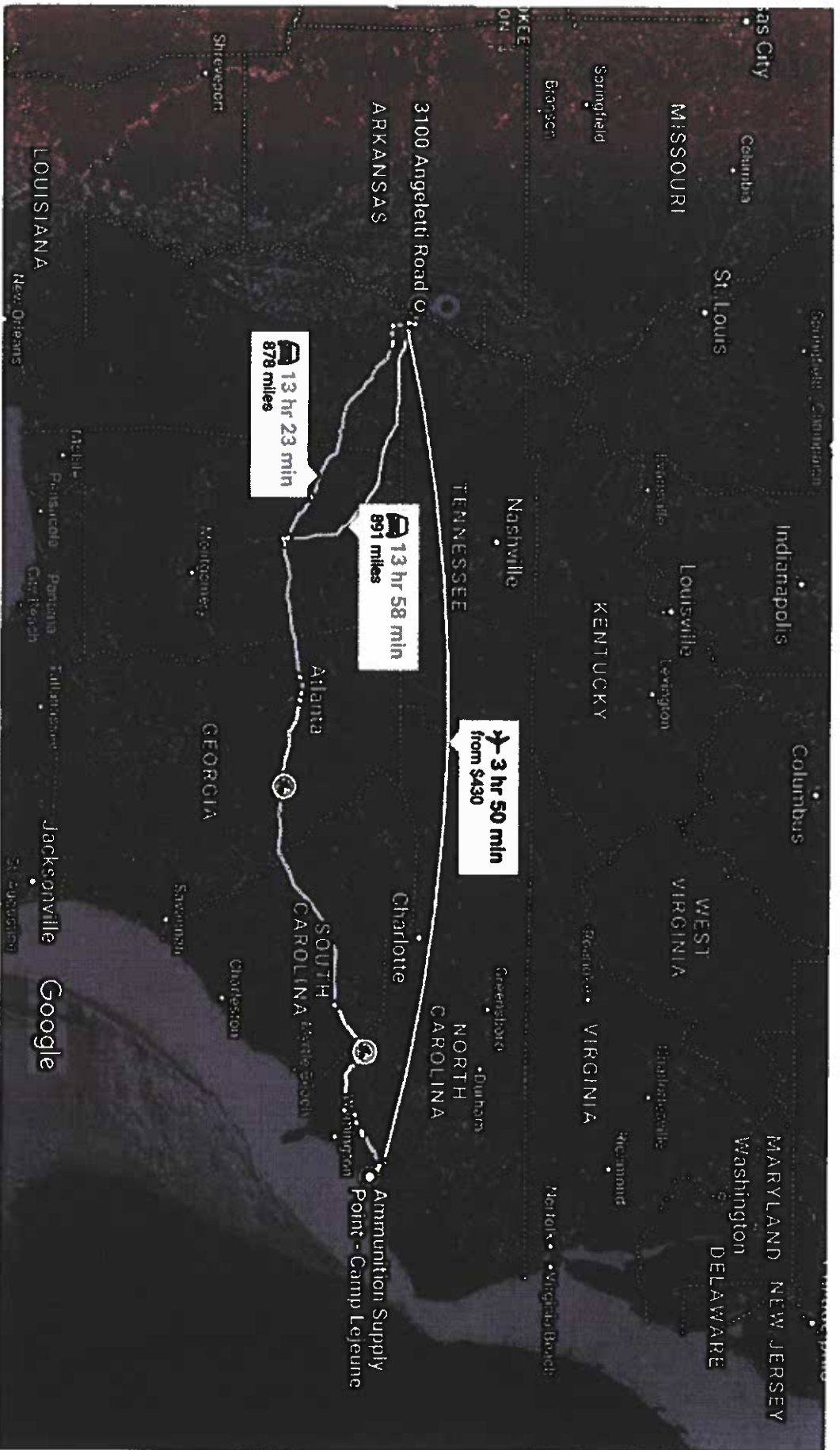
10. Refueling and Rest Stop Plan: The explosive laden vehicle and chaser vehicle will properly be fueled prior to loading ammunition at the ASP. There are four pre-determined refueling checkpoints, located at 2024 W Lucus St, Florence, SC 29501 (182 miles from the starting destination), 1981 Eatonton Rd, Madison, GA 30650 (232 miles from the last stop), 5500 W Hwy 78 W, Jasper, AL 35501 (240 miles from the last stop), 30 Goodman Rd E., South Haven, MS38671 (181 miles from the last stop). While conducting the refueling process, the explosive laden vehicle and chaser vehicle will block off all adjacent or near gas station pumps. In addition, they will set up a Fire Watch, 25 feet in diameter from the explosive laden vehicle to prevent any potential mishaps with in-coming vehicles or personnel. During the refueling procedure, they will properly fuel all vehicles in compliance, following the regulations and guidelines set and identified by NAVSEA SWO20-AF-HBK-010, par 5-12 (page 5-15). All safety procedures identified in NAVSEA SWO20-AF-HBK-010, par 5-12 will be followed. A copy of the NAVSEA SWO20-AF-HBK-010, Seventh Revision (Glove Box Edition) will be given to the explosive laden vehicle and the convoy commander to review and discuss the scheme of maneuvers before departure. The Battalion Ammunition Chief will discuss and cover specific information with the drivers and convoy commander prior to execution. Both drivers for the explosive laden vehicle and the chaser vehicle will conduct a personnel swap once they accumulate six hours of driving. The explosive laden vehicle driver will conduct his personnel swap with the other certified Ammunition Driver.

POTENTIAL HAZARDS

FIRE OR EXPLOSION

- MAY EXPLODE AND THROW FRAGMENTS 800 METERS (1/2 MILE) OR MORE IF FIRE REACHES CARGO.
- For information on "Compatibility Group" letters, refer to Glossary section.

HEALTH

- Fire may produce irritating, corrosive and/or toxic gases.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- CALL 911. Then call emergency response telephone number on shipping paper. If shipping paper not available or no answer, refer to appropriate telephone number listed on the inside back cover.
- Move people out of line of sight of the scene and away from windows.
- Keep unauthorized personnel away.
- Stay upwind, uphill and/or upstream.
- Ventilate closed spaces before entering, but only if properly trained and equipped.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

- Wear positive pressure self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA).
- Structural firefighters' protective clothing provides thermal protection but only limited chemical protection.

EVACUATION

Immediate precautionary measure

- Isolate spill or leak area immediately for at least 100 meters (330 feet) in all directions.

Large Spill

- Consider initial evacuation for 250 meters (800 feet) in all directions.

Fire

- If rail car or trailer is involved in a fire, ISOLATE for 800 meters (1/2 mile) in all directions; also initiate evacuation including emergency responders for 800 meters (1/2 mile) in all directions.
- If fire threatens cargo area containing packages bearing the 1.4S label or packages containing material classified as 1.4S, consider isolating at least 15 meters (50 feet) in all directions.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

FIRE

CARGO Fire

- **DO NOT** fight fire when fire reaches cargo! Cargo may **EXPLODE!**
- Stop all traffic and clear the area for at least 800 meters (1/2 mile) in all directions and let burn.
- Do not move cargo or vehicle if cargo has been exposed to heat.

TIRE or VEHICLE Fire

- Use plenty of water - **FLOOD it!** If water is not available, use CO₂, dry chemical or dirt.
- If possible, and **WITHOUT RISK**, use unmanned master stream devices or monitor nozzles from maximum distance to prevent fire from spreading to cargo area.
- Pay special attention to tire fires as re-ignition may occur. Stand by, at a safe distance, with extinguisher ready for possible re-ignition.

CLASS 1.4S Fire

- Packages bearing the 1.4S label or packages containing material classified as 1.4S are designed or packaged in such a manner that when involved in a fire, they may burn vigorously with localized detonations and projection of fragments.
- Effects are usually confined to immediate vicinity of packages.
- Fight fire with normal precautions from a reasonable distance.

SPILL OR LEAK

- **ELIMINATE** all ignition sources (no smoking, flares, sparks or flames) from immediate area.
- All equipment used when handling the product must be grounded.
- Do not touch or walk through spilled material.
